

Article 20.

Foreigners are allowed to enter when they meet the following conditions:

1. Possession of a valid passport or travel document and visa. Foreigners entering under unilateral visa exemption must have passports valid for at least 6 months and must have been outside Viet Nam for at least 30 days since their last departure.
2. Not falling under any of the cases prohibited from entry as stipulated in Article 21 of this Law.

Article 21.

Cases Prohibited from Entry

1. Not meeting the conditions stipulated in Clause 1 of Article 20 of this Law.
2. Children under 14 years old who are not accompanied by parents, guardians, or authorized persons.
3. Using forged documents or providing false information to obtain documents for entry, exit, or residence.
4. Persons with mental illnesses or infectious diseases that pose a danger to public health.
5. Being deported from Viet Nam within 3 years from the effective date of the deportation decision.
6. Being required to leave Viet Nam within 6 months from the effective date of the expulsion decision.
7. For epidemic prevention and control reasons.
8. Due to natural disasters.
